

**JOHN C. REED MD SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION**  
**INTRODUCTORY COURSE: OSTEOPATHY IN THE CRANIAL FIELD**

The John C. Reed, MD Fund (the “Fund”) maintained in The Cranial Academy Foundation, Inc. (“Foundation”) has been established to help support a scholarship each year for deserving MD residents to attend The Cranial Academy 40-hour Introductory Course in Osteopathy in the Cranial Field and/or its Annual Conference.

The intent of the fund is to expose and train academically affiliated medical residents in the cranial concept at a time in their careers where they can apply this knowledge to patient care in either clinical or research settings while they are still within their allopathic residency or fellowship program. Preference would be given to family practice, pediatrics or physical medicine residents who are in medical school academic residencies where clinical research is encouraged and there is a medical school commitment to teaching, practice or research in integrative medicine.

- (a) The Trustees shall select qualified candidate(s) who are graduates of a Medical or Osteopathic College who will have substantially completed their first residency year and have at least 12 months remaining in their academic residency or residency and fellowship training following the completion of their Cranial Basic Course.
- (b) The Trustees shall determine criteria for selection of the grantees, including but not limited to the following:
  - a. Recommendation of the grantee’s residency director
  - b. Prior or current exposure and/or experience in manual or bioenergetics therapy
  - c. Availability of clinical practice patients suitable for evaluation and treatment using the cranial concept (typically would encompass programs in pediatric medicine, physical medicine or family practice)
  - d. Opportunity for the grantee to subsequently participate in clinical or basic research involving the cranial concept.
